Interpretations does not publish fiction or poetry and at present it does not seek book reviews.

Submissions should normally be between 4000 and 6000 words in length including Endnotes and bibliographic material.

The inaugural issue is scheduled to be published (in print) in July/August 2024.

Basic Guidelines for Manuscript Submission

Writing Format

The **MANUSCRIPT** must be submitted in MS Words. Manuscripts should be typed using Times New Roman font, size 12; with a margin of 1" on four sides, aligned left (NOT justified); it should be prepared in accordance with the stipulated guidelines of MLA Handbook (9th edition). The Title of the Manuscript should be 14 in font size and with Centred alignment.

The author's name or any identifying information should NOT be there in the manuscript in any form.

A precise **ABSTRACT** explaining problematical aspects, objectives, methodology and findings should be submitted along with the article in a separate file. In the Abstract file authors should put their name, designation, institutional affiliation, address for correspondence, E-Mail ID and contact no.

A **DECLARATION BY THE AUTHOR** should be accompanied with the abstract (for details of the declaration and a template, please check – https://sukantacollege.org/)
